

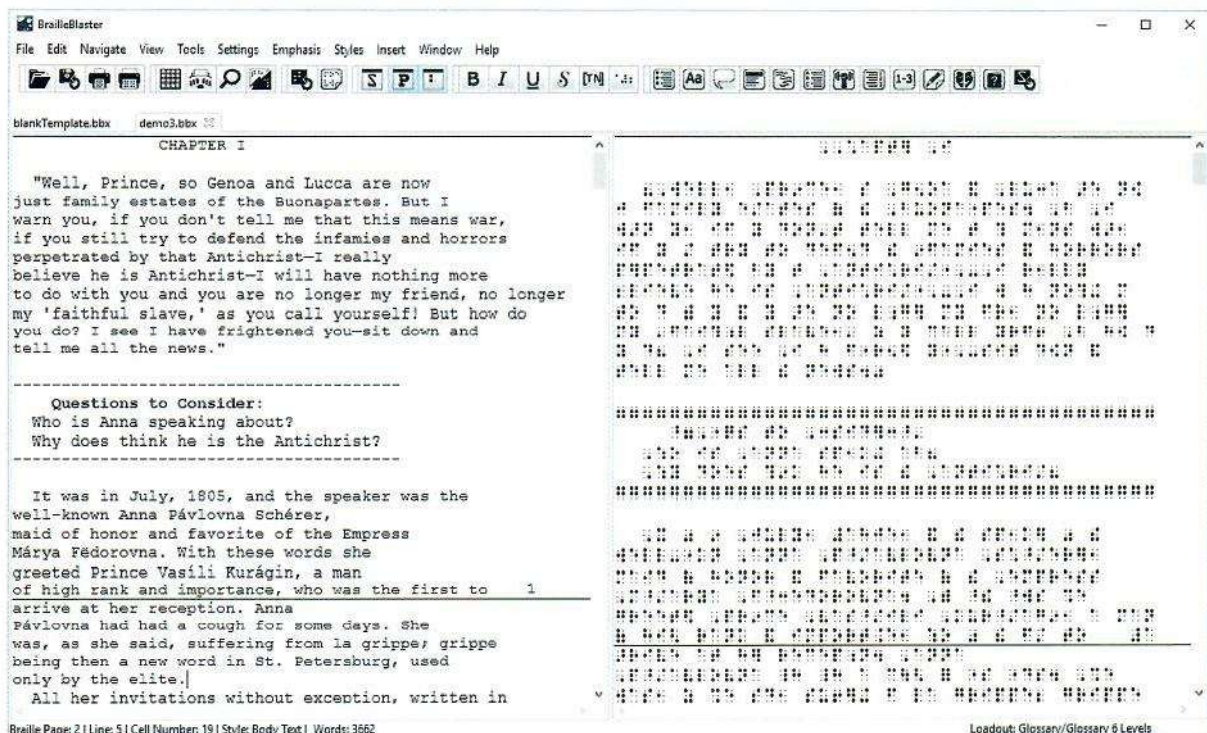


Details of the Software procured for providing the assistance

BrailleBlaster

BrailleBlaster is a Braille transcription program developed by the American Printing House for the Blind to help transcribers provide blind students with braille textbooks on the first day of class. Designed primarily for editing textbooks that meet the specifications published by the Braille Authority of North America, the purpose of BrailleBlaster is to help braille producers ensure that every student has their braille textbooks on the first day of class. BrailleBlaster relies on Liblouis, a well-known open-source braille translator, for translating text and mathematics to braille. It is open source software.
